- We should be evaluating the apps we chose to use with our students



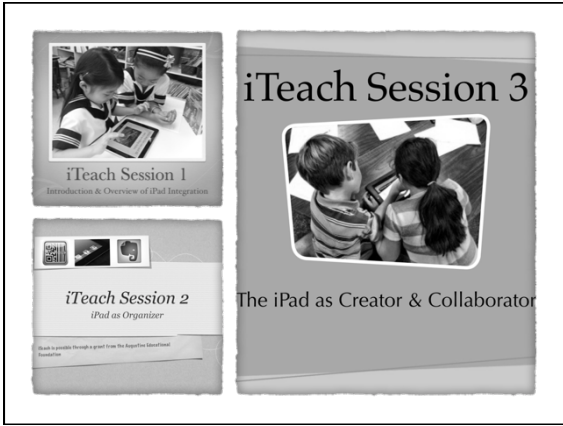
